The city of Matosinhos was born from a community of fishermen. Known as the best Fish in the World, it is coveted by the most well-known Chefs. Take a seat at one of the many restaurants and taste the best fish in the World!

After a magnificent meal, enjoy a walk by the seafront, designed by Álvaro Siza Vieira and Eduardo Souto Moura, the two Pritzker prizes of architecture in Portugal! But if your motivation is cultural, you can visit the Museum House of the Santiago Farmstead, the Conceição Farmstead, with its Baroque heritage designed by Nicolau Nazoni, the City Hall Building or an exhibition at the Gerardo Rueda Modern Arts Centre.

- >> Sightseeing tour along the Atlantic seafront of Matosinhos. Tea at the Boa Nova Tea House.
- >> Visit to the Bom Jesus Church of Matosinhos where one of the biggest festivals of Portugal is celebrated: Senhor de Matosinhos (20 min).
- >> Visit to the Matosinhos City Hall (work by Alcino Soutinho) and the Gerardo Rueda Modern Arts Centre.
- >> Shopping in the Matosinhos shopping area, passing through the Matosinhos Market and the Espaço Quadra (Quadra Space) (60 min).
- >> Lunch at a restaurant in Matosinhos (90 min).
- >> Visit to the Museum House of the Santiago Farmstead.
- >> Stroll through the Conceição Farmstead.
- >> Return to the port.

Programme with restrictions on Mondays and Sundays
 Degree of difficulty of the walk along the seafront: low.
 Degree of difficulty of the walk in the Conceição Farmstead: high (not accessible to citizens with reduced mobility).
 Market is closed on Sundays.

The Boa Nova Tea House and the Museum House of the Santiago Farmstead are closed on Mondays.
