Contemporary Porto

A privileged space to admire architecture.





Porto, and particularly Matosinhos, is a backdrop to the most important Portuguese School of Architecture. The 'School of Porto' is acknowledged as one of the most remarkable in Europe. During this tour, you will visit buildings designed by two of the most important contemporary architects: Álvaro Siza Vieira and Souto Moura, both awarded with the Pritzker prize. You will have the opportunity to visit the Contemporary Art Museum of the Serralves Foundation located inside a property that also has the best example of an Art Deco garden in Portugal and one of the most impressive Portuguese private homes.

- >> Sightseeing tour along the Leça da Palmeira seafront, a project by the architect Siza Vieira, where you can visit the Tide Pool or the Boa Nova Tea House.
- >> Sightseeing tour along the Matosinhos seafront, designed by the architect Souto Moura, up to the roundabout with the Anemone or 'She Moves', a piece by the American sculptor Janet Echelman. The tour continues up Avenida da Boavista towards Rotunda da Boavista.
- >> Visit to the Music Hall (60 min).
- >> Visit to the Villa and gardens of Serralves and the Contemporary Art Museum (90 min)
- >> Return to the port.
